


### **Martin DRS1**

The Martin DRS1 is a balanced and chimey dreadnought styled guitar. Traditional styling along with the legendary Martin quality make this guitar the perfect guitar for the professional touring musician.

# **Martin DRS1**

The Martin DRS1 Dreadnought Acoustic-Electric Guitar is the return of Martin's Road Series. This guitar is designed for those musicians who can't compromise on budget or tone. Martin knows how to pull off quality without breaking the band. The DRS1 comes equipped with an on-board pickup ands solid sapele top, back and sides.





#### Headstock

The Martin DRS1 comes featured with a tapered headstock. The headplate is an Indian Rosewood HPL (High Pressure Laminate). The classic Martin & Co. badging fisnishes off this orginal dreadnought style.

## **Tuning Machines**

This guitar comes standard with chrome finished tuners. The brilliant chrome finish compliments the richness of the wood and with Martin quality, you know you'll always hold the tune.

#### Nut

Made from durable white corian, the Martin DRS1 nut is sure to withstand years of roadware and gigging. Be sure to use Martin SP acoustic strings for optimized life and durability.

#### Neck

The DRS1 fingerboard features a richlite top along with a rust stratabond reinforced neck. Martin took extra measures to make sure the DRS1 holds up to life on the road. The DRS1 also features a mortise/tenon style neck joint for optimized durability.

## **Top Material**

The Martin DRS1 is constructed from solid Sapele wood. The top, back and sides all are treated with a satin finish for that vintage look and feel. The sapele offers a rich, balanced tone that is bound to compliment many styles of playing.

## **Bridge**

Made from black richlite, the bridge of the DRS1 is durable to say the least. This belly style bridge features 2- 1/8" string spacing with white pearl end pins.
